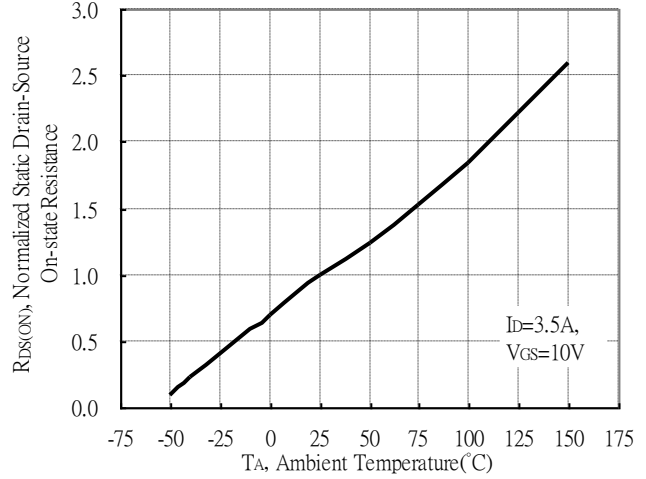

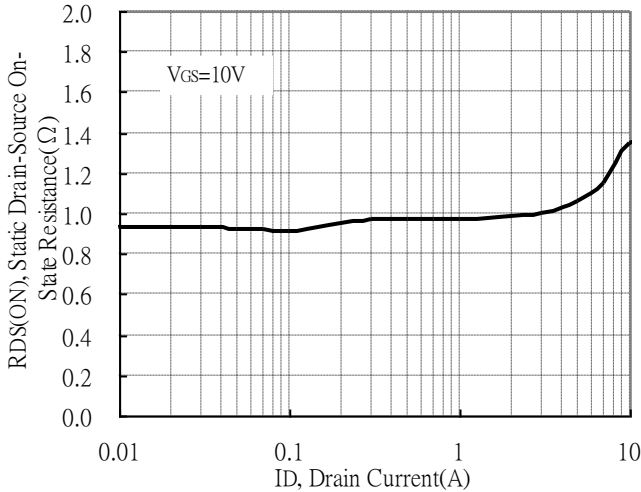
Typical Output Characteristics



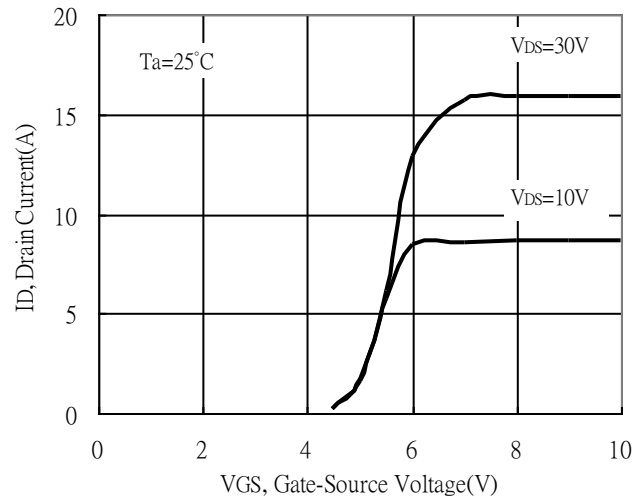
Static Drain-Source On-resistance vs Ambient Temperature



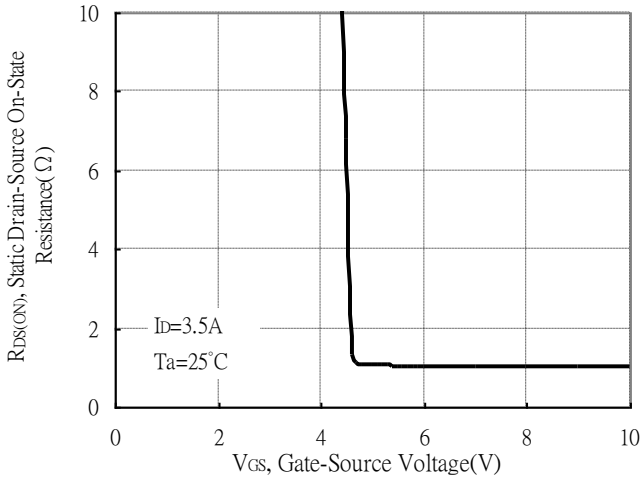
Static Drain-Source On-State resistance vs Drain Current



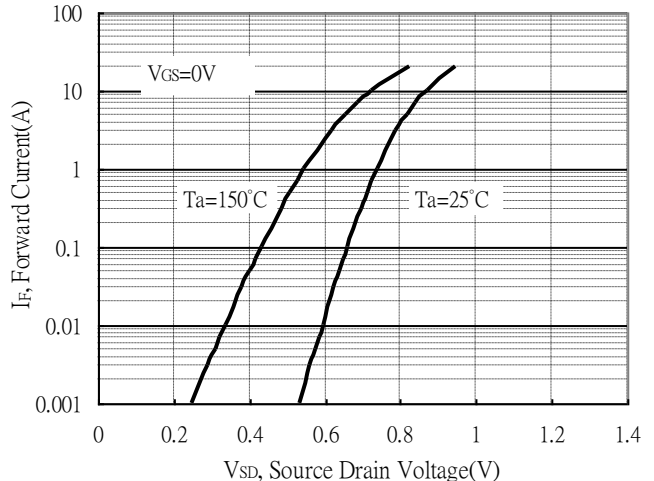
Drain Current vs Gate-Source Voltage



Static Drain-Source On-State Resistance vs Gate-Source Voltage

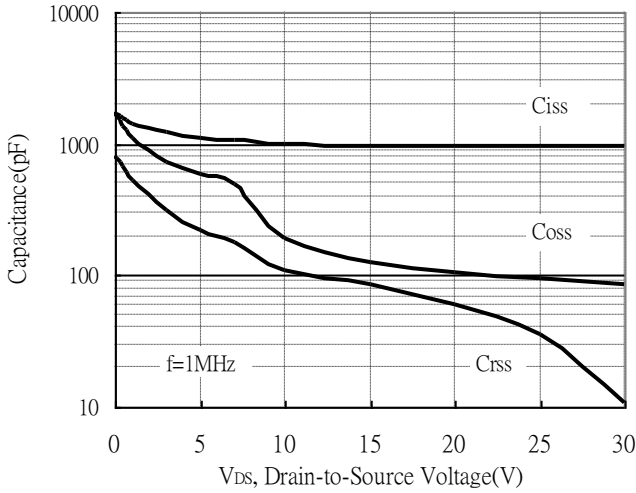


Forward Drain Current vs Source-Drain Voltage

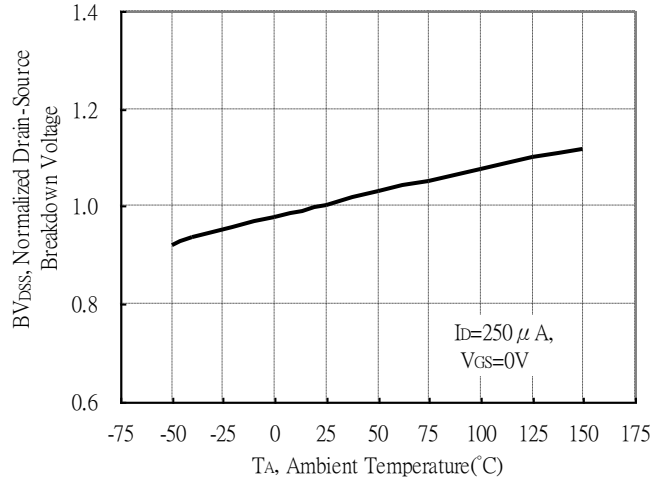

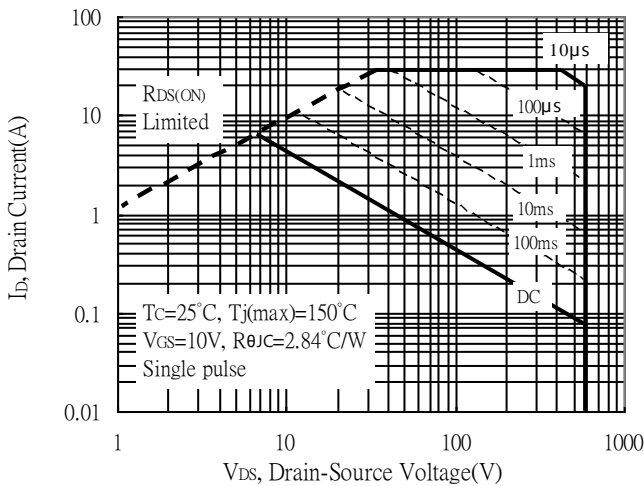
Capacitance vs Reverse Voltage



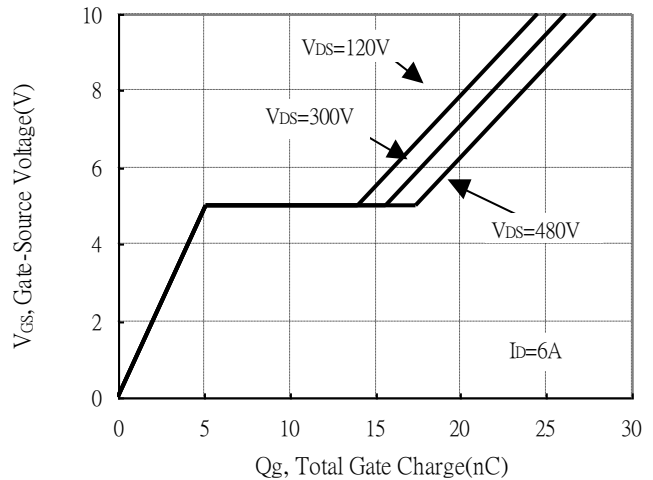
Brekdown Voltage vs Ambient Temperature



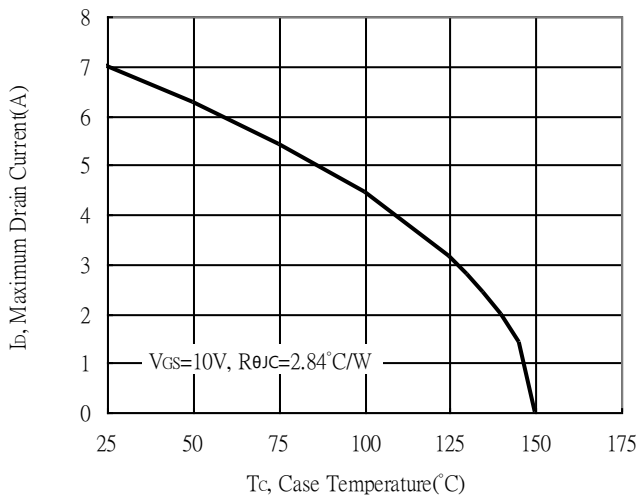
Maximum Safe Operating Area



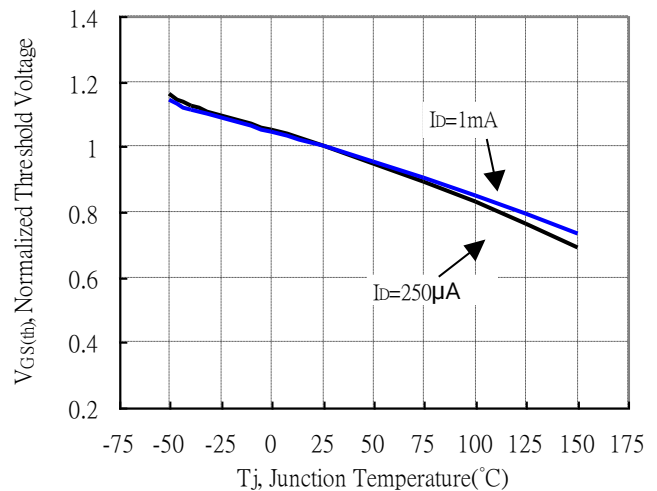
Gate Charge Characteristics



Maximum Drain Current vs Case Temperature

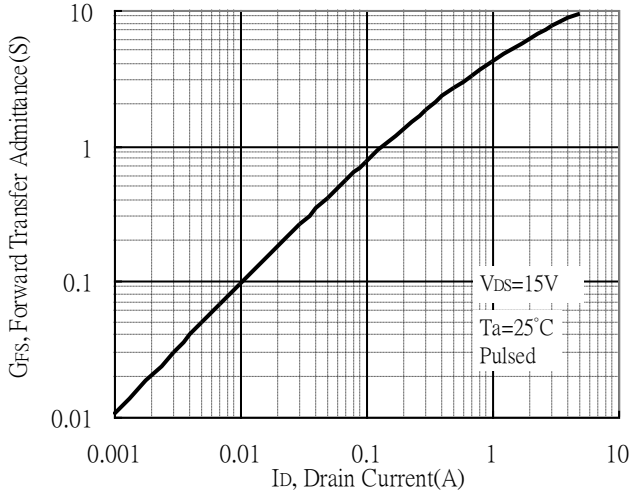


Threshold Voltage vs Junction Temperature

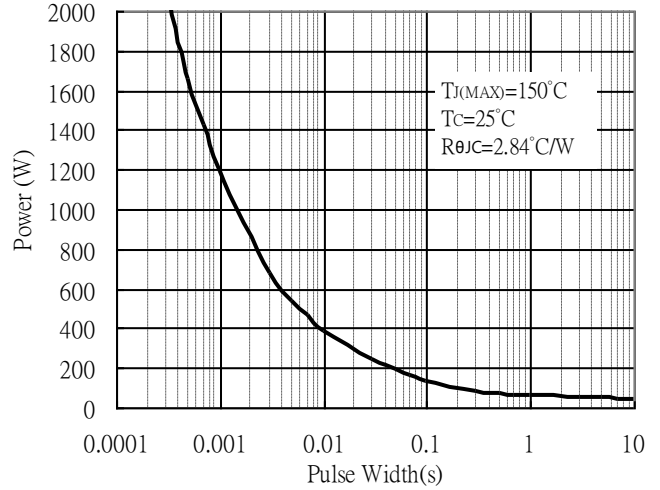

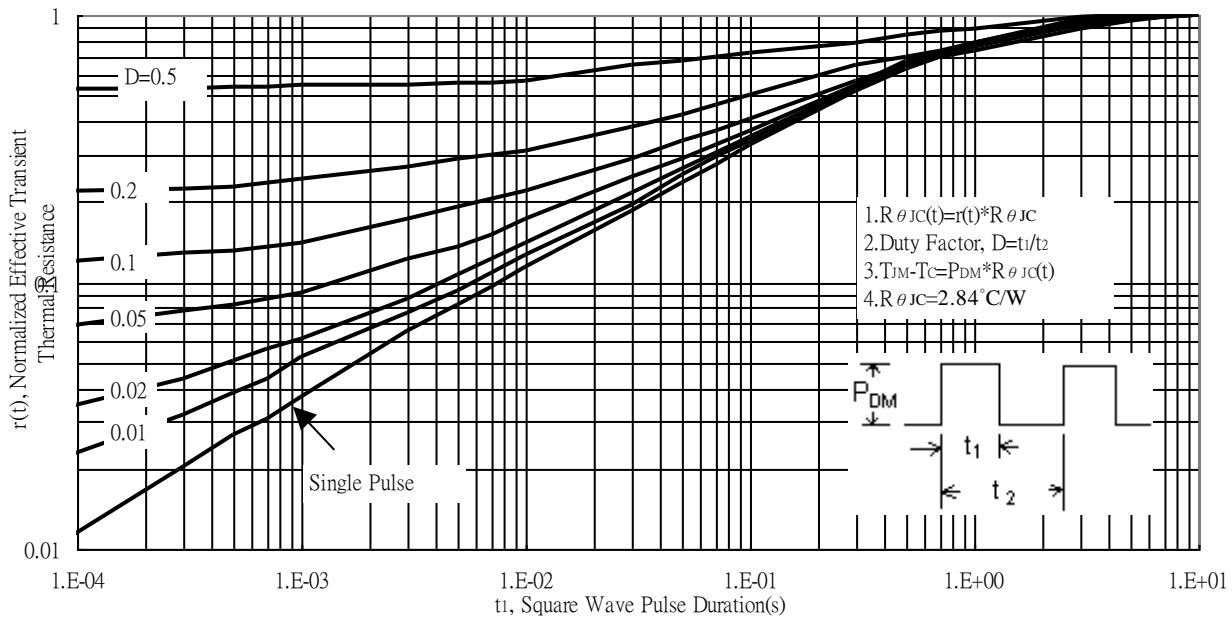
Forward Transfer Admittance vs Drain Current



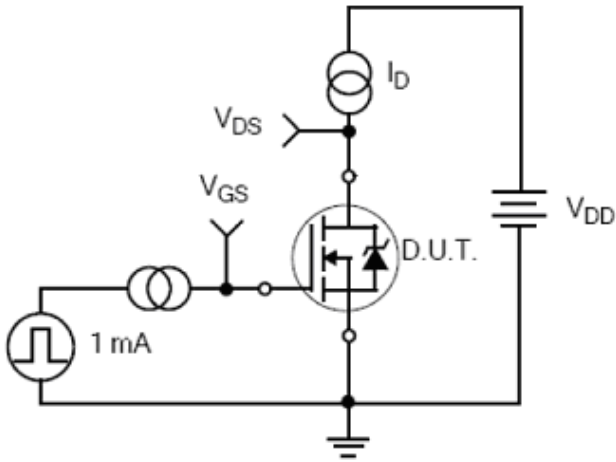
Single Pulse Power Rating, Junction to Case



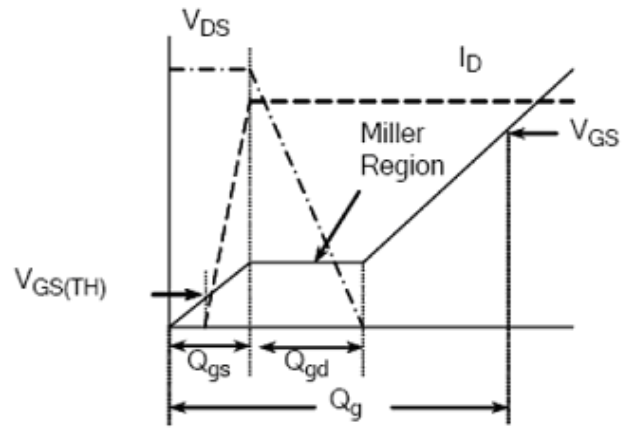
Transient Thermal Response Curves



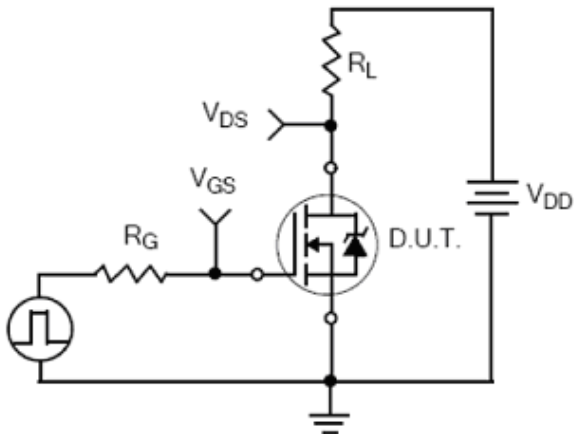

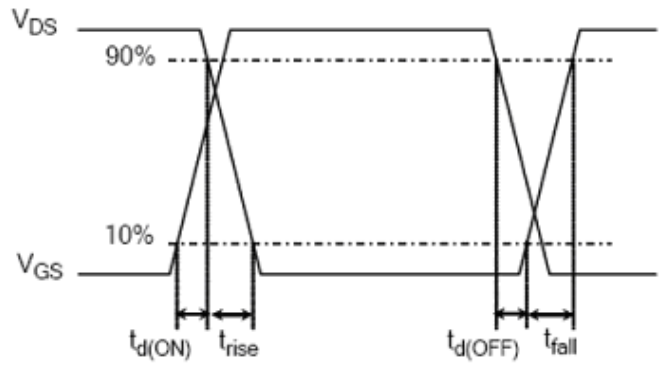
Gate Charge Test Circuit



Gate Charge Waveform

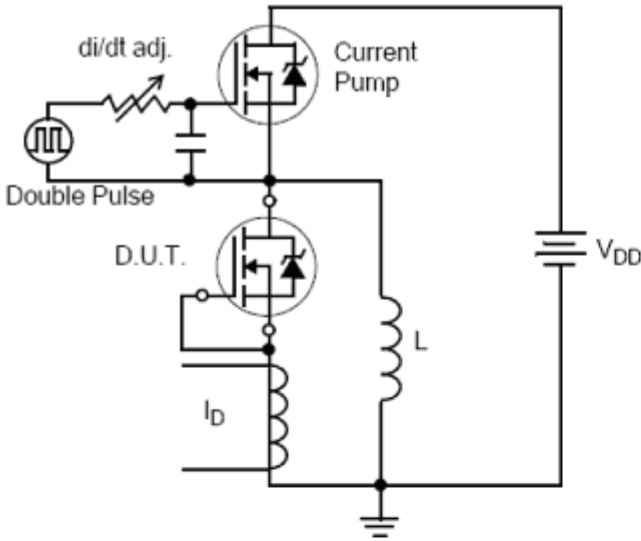


Resistive Switching Test Circuit

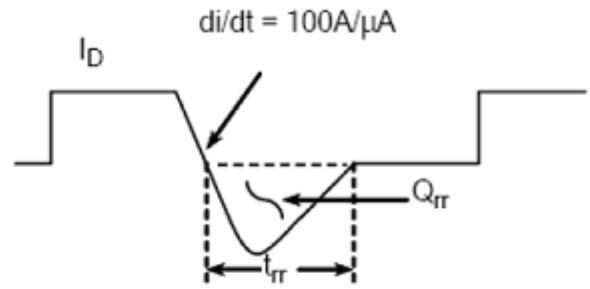


Resistive Switching Waveforms

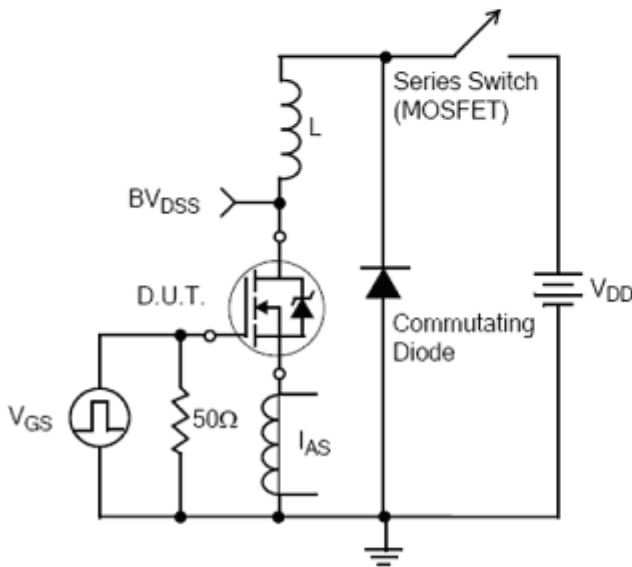

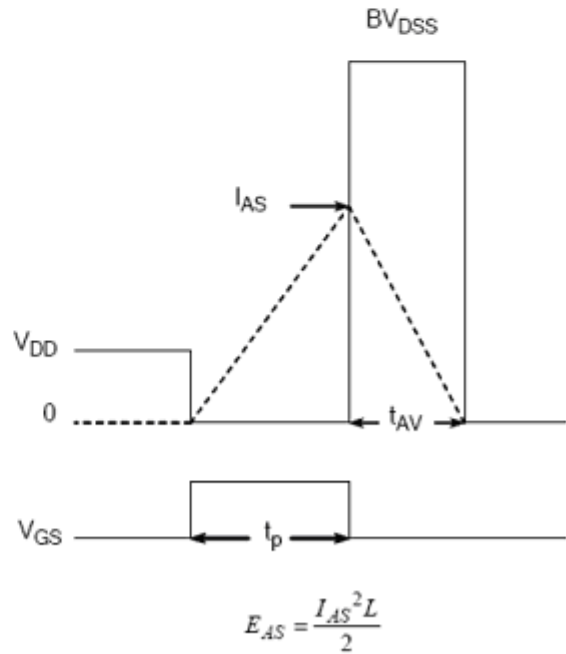
Diode Reverse Recovery Test Circuit



Diode Reverse Recovery Waveform



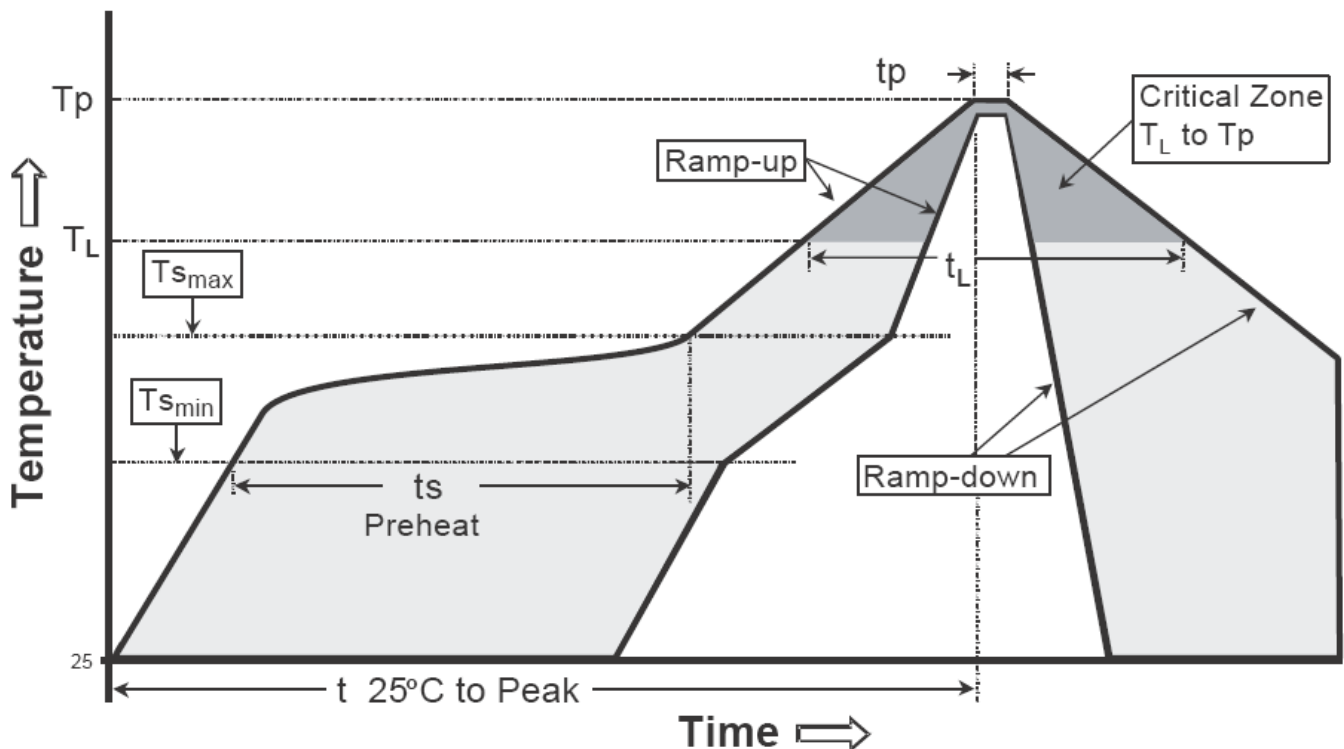
Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit


